A new venture from Julian Chichester

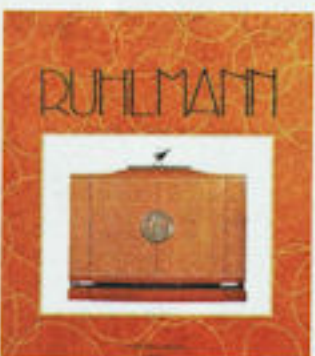

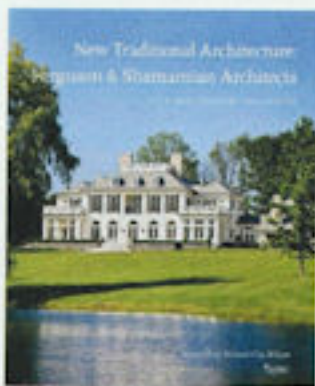
